2020 Signature Sensations - Cancelled

The Executive Committee of the Jean B. Purvis Community Health Center made the difficult decision to cancel the 2020 Signature Sensations special event that was scheduled for November 6, 2020 at the Butler Country Club. Because of the uncertainty of the Coronavirus Pandemic, the event will be rescheduled for this year. Our plan is to hold the event on Saturday, November 6, 2021 if conditions permit.

There are a couple of reasons for cancelling the event. First and foremost is the safety of our constituents, volunteers and staff. Until the pandemic is under control, we do not want to put anyone at risk of being exposed to the virus. Secondly, Butler Country Club is currently allowed to have a maximum of 25 people gathered indoors. Our normal attendance for this special event is approximately 200. There has been no indication that this restriction will be lifted soon.

This event has been a significant income generator for the Center - approximately 15% of our yearly budget. Fortunately, we have received several generous and unexpected gifts during the past six months that will help us weather the storm. We will also be contacting all of the past attendees and sponsors, asking them to support the Center with a donation in lieu of attending or sponsoring the event.

I would like to thank all of you for your support of this event and hope that we can count on your continued support. Stay safe.

We have a new dental patient - we will call him Joe. He is a 66 year-old homeless veteran, currently staying in a Veteran shelter. This Veteran served during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in August of 1971.

Joe is one of the Veterans who does not receive dental care through the VA, so the VA referred him to us at the Community Health Center. Joe is in need of an upper denture, which currently, we are unable to do in-house. Our Dr. McHugh, Tina & Lauren saw him here at the Center, his teeth were cleaned and x-rays were taken. Dr. McHugh determined that he was a good candidate for dentures.

We reached out to one of our long-time volunteers, Dr. Todd. Dr. Todd will do the work at his dental office and will donate his time and supplies.

The American Legion will pay the lab fees for the actual making of the dentures.

Working together, we make a difference! This Veteran will not only get a new set of teeth, but also his dignity.

COVID-19 and Adult CPR

If an adult's heart stops and you're worried that they may have COVID-19, you can still help by performing Hands-Only CPR.

Step 1



Phone 9-1-1 and get an AED.

Step 2



Cover your own mouth and nose with a face mask or cloth.



Cover the person's mouth and nose with a face mask or cloth.

Step 3



Perform Hands-Only CPR.
Push hard and fast on the center of the chest at a rate of 100 to 120 compressions per minute.

Step 4



Use an AED as soon as it is available.
